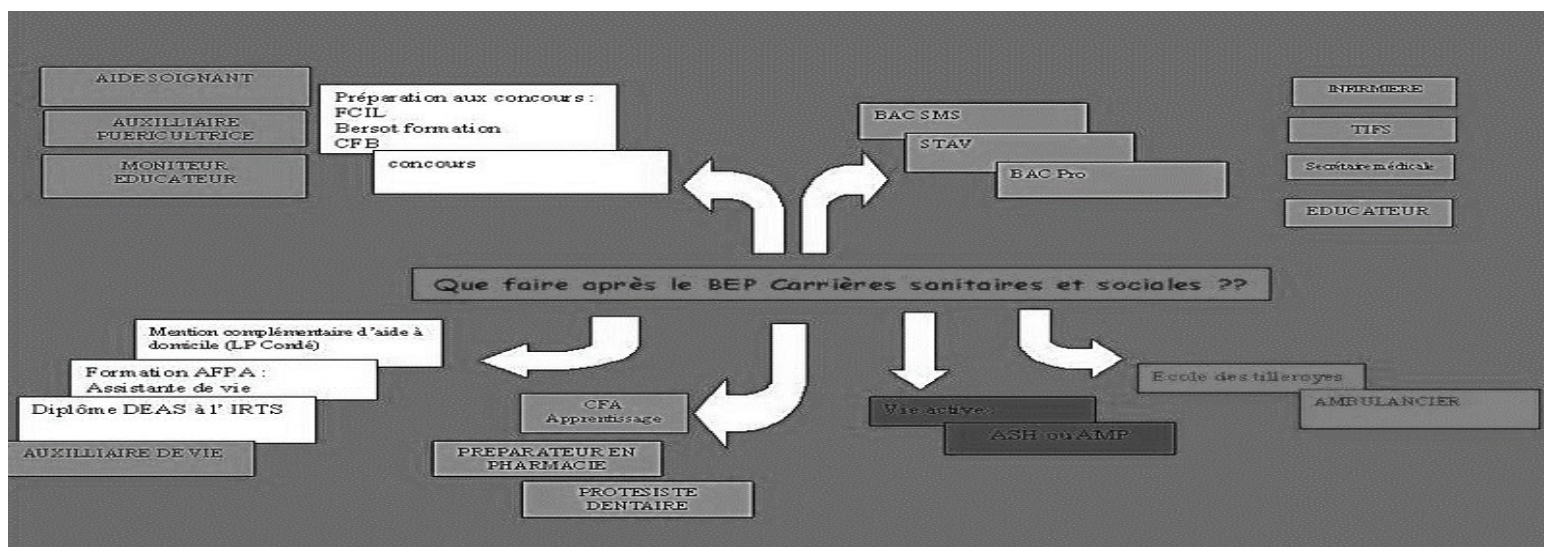

Opportunities :

The candidate for this BEP must be aware that this diploma opens up few possibilities for direct professional integration; he/she will have to take competitive examinations and continue his/her training to enter the various professional sectors of a health and social nature, namely services related to early childhood (crèches, maternity wards, day nurseries, nursery schools), social and medico-social services and establishments for the disabled and the elderly (retirement homes, hostels, homes for the disabled), hospitalisation, care and treatment services (hospitals, clinics, treatment and convalescent homes), pharmacies.

Description

In the health field: to meet the needs of people (children, teenagers, the disabled, the very old, adults who are not self-sufficient) in a collective environment, in terms of hygiene, comfort, safety and motor skills.

In the social field: to respond to the needs of people in terms of leisure and communication, to take charge of groups around animation projects or socio-educational activities.

By ensuring the reception, personal hygiene, food, comfort and safety of people, as well as the maintenance and hygiene of the spaces where they live;

By helping people to acquire autonomy, by accompanying and stimulating them in the acts of daily life, if necessary

By organising activities (in the same day, for example, after the person has been washed and their room cleaned, an activity is organised and a snack is prepared)

Quality and competences :

Students who are destined for this training must have a good psychological balance, good self-control, a sense of discipline, but also a taste for human contact. These qualities are indispensable: the slightest mistake can have serious consequences when working, not in a simulation, but with children and the elderly.
