This BEP is rather oriented towards further studies in a vocational baccalaureate, after which the young person will be required to work in a "shop", this term designating a place where goods are stored and kept, otherwise known as a "logistics platform", "warehouse" or "storehouse". However, there are still opportunities for employment in the field of materials handling at BEP level.

Description

To carry out, within a team and under the authority of a "shop" manager, the administrative and handling operations relating to the 3 sectors of logistics: reception of goods, storage and dispatch. The holder of a vocational baccalaureate with experience can reach a position of responsibility in one of these 3 sectors according to his personal qualities and his motivation.

The storekeeper greets delivery personnel, ensures "physical" and administrative reception: he/she carries out checks and controls, arranges the goods in the warehouse according to the layout plans, carries out computer entry to update the stocks. They also prepare and dispatch orders: they take the goods out, pack,

weigh and palletise them; they fill in the documents for transport and help load the vehicle.

Quality and competences :

The students who are destined for this BEP have a taste for contact and an ability to integrate into a team. They must have a rather dynamic personality, as this activity requires liveliness and a sustained work rhythm. It is desirable that the student is capable of taking initiatives and is not reluctant to use the computer as a working tool. The qualities of rigour, seriousness and honesty are essential.
