## **Description:**

This diploma trains to run a dog or cat breeding business.

The head of the company or the person in charge of the breeding establishes a selection plan for the animals and controls their reproduction. He or she assesses their state of health and behaviour, chooses and prepares the food, and adapts the rations to each animal.

He or she maintains the equipment and buildings, and organises the purchase and sale of animals in accordance with the regulations in force.

Finally, it is possible to offer additional services (training, boarding, etc.).

## **Quality and competences:**

The vocational training certificate (bac pro) for the running and management of a dog and cat business trains students in the breeding of dogs and cats.

The student assimilates the techniques enabling him or her to look after the animals: feeding them, monitoring them, caring for them, practising their basic education, identifying the characteristics of dogs and cats, etc. He or she acquires selection and reproduction techniques, but also learns to maintain the

premises (cleaning, disinfection), equipment and materials in compliance with the animals' well-being and the rules of hygiene and safety.

The knowledge acquired during the vocational baccalaureate gives him the ability to monitor cash flow, draw up accounting documents specific to the management of the farm, and make the necessary adjustments to achieve the objectives set. The student also assimilates the techniques of communication, promotion and advice for the marketing of the animals in his possession.
