## **Branch: Handicrafts and crafts (hc)**

**Option:** Upholsterer of furnishings

**Level**: Bac Pro **Prerequisites**: **Opportunities**:

Graduates work in an industrial workshop or with a craftsman or woman. In industrial companies, they can, for example, make car seats or aircraft seats.

## **Description:**

In an industrial setting, based on the idea or project of the creative designer, the holders of this diploma produce a prototype intended to be reproduced in limited or large numbers. In a methods office, they carry out sampling, choose the appropriate materials, draw up a production schedule and calculate a provisional price.

The upholsterer option covers the covering of furniture, armchairs, walls and windows. Upholsterers contribute to the interior decoration of a new or old building. They shape fabrics, soft materials and foams for upholstery and decoration and install them.

## Quality and competences:

The Bac Pro upholsterer trains students to dress and upholster seats and bedding, in restoration or creation. This may involve dressing floors as well as walls and windows with textile coverings: wall fabrics, carpets, rugs, hangings, etc.

The students learn the different techniques for laying and setting up a tapestry. They draw up the layout before any operation by studying and measuring the surface to be fitted out.

During the course, students learn the different techniques of shaping, assembling and finishing: nailing, gluing, sewing of wall hangings.

The management courses will enable them to ensure the flow of supplies, the monitoring of production and the site, and to organise quality control.

The work of upholsterers is mostly done in the workshop.
