Graduates work for a service provider, in a forestry operation, a sawmill, a cooperative or a forestry group.

He or she can also find a job with a landowner, a forestry expert or with the National Forestry Office (through a competitive examination).

It is also possible to set up on your own and become a company manager.

Description :

This diploma allows you to work in a forestry company, a sawmill, a cooperative, or on behalf of a private or public forest owner.

It involves carrying out forestry maintenance operations or felling and processing work.

Participate in the management of a site: estimate, preparation and organisation of work in compliance with safety rules and techniques.

Quality and competences :

The forestry vocational diploma trains students in silviculture and wood exploitation. Students learn to recognise trees, evaluate their volume, understand how to organise teamwork on a site and how to adapt their behaviour

and technical gestures according to the nature of the terrain and the objective of the site.

They are trained to carry out maintenance and renewal work on forest stands such as seeding and planting, pruning. They also carry out felling, shaping and skidding work to evacuate the felled timber.

The teaching covers the safe use of forestry equipment and machinery as well as their first level of maintenance.

The knowledge acquired in management enables the student to analyse the financial and economic situation of the company and to participate in drawing up estimates.
