Description:

Holders of this vocational baccalaureate hold jobs as prototypists in design offices or as assemblers. They work in the mid-range sector as well as in the luxury sector, in SMEs or VSEs. Prototypists produce the part that will be used to launch mass production. They must take into account the indications given by the stylists or model makers, as well as the technical constraints and production costs. They define the cutting process, check the aesthetic, functional and technical conformity of the piece produced. They draw up the technical data sheets transmitted to the methods office. Design offices, the luxury sector and small series recruit most of the prototypists in France, while large series production of mid-range products is outsourced. As for the holders of the leather goods option, they carry out all the actions specific to the realization of the prototype in leather goods: bag, belt...

Quality and skills:

During their training, students learn to make a model prior to the prototype by complying with a set of specifications and respecting the designers' drawings. Thanks to the lessons on materials and on the industrialization of products, they are prepared to adopt the most suitable technical and aesthetic solutions for the assembly and the choice of materials.

The students will have to assimilate the techniques to make the pattern manually or in CAD, the templates that will be used to make the parts, cut the elements of the prototype, carry out the assembly and the finishing touches.

They also acquire the necessary skills to participate in the elaboration of an industrialization file and to follow the execution of a small series.

The lessons on control and quality will enable them to ensure the final control of the product. The training leaves a lot of room for the project approach and applied arts
