Graduates mainly work in the following organisations: logistics providers, distribution platforms, transport companies providing logistics services, certain other organisations (hospitals, associations, etc.).

In the context of a first professional integration, they can be: logisticians, forklift drivers, receptionists....

After a first experience, they will be: team leaders, warehouse managers

**Description :**

Holders of the Logistics Baccalaureate participate in the organisation and management of the logistics chain. They are required to receive and dispatch goods, place them in stock and ensure their computerised management. They know how to use handling equipment, prepare orders and contribute to destocking. They work mainly in companies providing handling, warehousing, storage and distribution services. After a few years' experience as warehouse operators, forklift operators or receptionists, these professionals can progress to positions as managers of a small logistics unit or warehouse managers (small unit) or stock managers.

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**Quality and competences :**

The aim of this vocational baccalaureate is to provide versatility, enabling students to work at all levels of the logistics chain: rigour and communication skills are essential.

Students learn to prepare and carry out reception and storage operations (incoming flows), to manage orders, destocking and shipping of goods (outgoing flows) as well as to master stock management software.

They are trained to drive handling equipment and to comply with procedures, safety rules, quality and environmental standards.

These skills are complemented by knowledge of the company's administrative and commercial management, and of communication (in French or a foreign language) in order to be able to work with external partners (suppliers, service providers, transporters, customers) or internal partners (logistics, administrative, commercial and accounting departments).
